What is the role of an EYSAC national representative?

- The EYSAC National Representatives Committee are the young ambassadors of ESSO, providing the link between the broader network and local surgical societies and hospitals within countries/regions.
- They help increase the visibility of ESSO within countries/regions and, possibly, increase ESSO membership.
- National representatives help to broaden the perspective of ESSO, sharing the standards of care, innovations, opportunities and challenges in their local setting to the rest of the EYSAC members.
- They can initiate such broader conversations or share ideas for collaborative projects as EYSAC National Representatives. These can contribute to improving and harmonising standards for surgical oncology training, patient care & research globally.

What do we expect from an EYSAC national representative?

General roles

- To be ESSO's young ambassadors - the link between your national society or institution and ESSO
- To help increase ESSO visibility within your countries and, possibly, increase ESSO membership
- To contribute to the overall ESSO aim that is improving and harmonising standards for surgical oncology training, patient care & research in Europe (and beyond)

Expected activities

- To participate in EYSAC NR virtual meetings, at least 2 times a year, and, if possible, at ESSO Congress
- To promote and participate in ESSO and EYSAC educational activities (webinars, courses, congresses, board certification exams)



- To motivate peers from your institution, society and country to join ESSO and EYSAC
- To propose or lead initiatives or projects at your own institutions (country) that can help improve main ESSO goals
- To share outcomes of any initiatives or activities with EYSAC Steering Committee (and broader EYSAC group)
- To ask for ESSO endorsement (support) in local educational events, possibly include speakers from ESSO and EYSAC

What do we offer?

- Recognition of your commitment to EYSAC and role of national representative in your country on the ESSO website and within the Surgical Oncology community;
- Networking opportunities with peers and key figures in the Surgical Oncology community;
- Possible future committee positions within ESSO;
- Opportunity to be involved in collaborative clinical trials;
- Assistance in highlighting surgical oncology as a specialty within your country.

Who can apply?

Any young ESSO member within 15 years of graduation.
